Community At A Glance

The Mehlville School District has 1 Early Childhood Center, 11 Elementary Schools, 4 Middle Schools and 2 High Schools serving just over 10,000 students who speak 51 different languages in South Saint Louis County, Missouri. The Mehlville High School student body is 10% African-American, 5% Asian, 5% Hispanic, 3% Multi-racial, 32% Free/Reduced Lunch, 14% Special Education Services, and 9% English Language Learners.

Academic Program

Class Schedule: The school calendar is divided into two semesters consisting of 3 terms each. The academic program is organized as an 8 block schedule, in which the classes meet every other day (4 blocks per day) on four day weeks. When there are five school days in a week, students attend all of their classes on Monday.

Advanced Placement: Mehlville High School offers 23 courses through the College Board Advanced Placement program. Students may begin taking AP courses in the sophomore year and may choose to sit for AP Exams in subjects for which we do not offer the companion AP course. Based on course demands, the 14 AP courses available this year are as follows: Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, European History, French, German, Human Geography, Physics, Psychology, Spanish, Statistics, Studio Art, U.S. Government & Politics, and World History.

Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment: MHS offers 29 courses which may be taken on the high school campus for dual credit through the University of Missouri-St. Louis, Saint Louis University, Missouri Baptist University, Missouri State University, Saint Louis Community College, and Lindenwood University. Additionally, students may take dual enrollment courses on local College/University Campuses, as well as online, to receive both high school and college credit.

GPA is based on 4.0 scale for (A=4 points). AP courses have an additional weight of 1.0 (A=5 points). PLTW courses have a weight of .75 (A=4.75). Dual Credit Courses have either a .75 or 1.0 weight based on School Board approval. We do not rank but have a Cum Laude System: Summa Cum Laude = 4.0 & above; Magna Cum Laude = 3.75-3.99; Cum Laude = 3.5-3.749. Valedictorian/Salutatorian are recognized at graduation.
