

Slick the bytton to go to your ICAP and complete the activities.




FIRST: CLICK ON "COURSE PLANNER"

First Click on the grade level you need to update.
(See Green Arrow)

You can see how many courses of the ones you have planned are officially completed. (See Red Arrow) Click on the Orange Corner of each planned course to edit courses to passed/failed for your first semester courses (or any other previous courses).

COMPLETED COURSES


When you mark your semester courses as passed and when you have passed both semesters of your yearlong courses - they will show up in green at the bottom of the grade level screen.



UPDATE ANY COURSE CHANGES FOR THIS SEMESTER

- 1. Check your transcript to make sure all of your completed courses for each grade level in your ICAP match the ones with passing grades on your transcript (yearlong courses will still be blue with the ½ complete).
- 2. Then make sure the courses you are currently taking are in the blue "Planned Courses" sections for your current grade level.
- 3. Look at the <u>23-24 Career & Course Planning Guide</u> to update each future grade level with the courses you plan to take.
- 4. Delete any courses you no longer want to take by clicking the orange corner edit pencil.
- See the next slide as a reminder from the Fall ICAP Lesson of how to add courses.

For example -Sociology is listed as a recommended course for my career path in 11th grade but I want to take it during senior year. So I will click on the save icon next to Sociology then change the grade level to 12th and pick the semester L want to take
