The Mehlville School District has 1 Early Childhood Center, 11 Elementary Schools, 4 Middle Schools and 2 High Schools serving just over 10,000 students in south Saint Louis County, Missouri. The Mehlville High School student body is comprised of students in the following demographic categories: 39.82% Free/Reduced Lunch, 5.03% Asian, 11.8% Black, 5.31% Hispanic, 0.35% American Indian, 6.35% Multi-racial, 2.55% 504 Plans, 15.18% Special Education and 13.67% English Language Learners.

Academic Program

Class Schedule: The school calendar is divided into two semesters and organized as an eight block schedule in which the classes meet every other day (four blocks per day). **Curriculum:** For more information, please link to the website listed below to review the Career & Course Planning Guide.

Advanced Placement: While the district has over twenty College Board Advanced Placement Courses listed in our curriculum, the actual number offered each year is based on student demand and teacher availability. Mehlville High School is currently offering thirteen AP courses. Students may begin taking AP courses in ninth grade. Students may choose to sit for AP Exams in subjects for which we do not offer the companion AP course.

Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment: MHS offers twenty-three courses which may be taken at MHS for dual credit through the University of Missouri-St. Louis, Saint Louis University, Missouri Baptist University, Missouri State University and Lindenwood University. Students may also take dual enrollment courses on local college campuses to receive both high school and college credit.

GPA & Cum Laude System for Class of 2023

GPA is based on 4.0 scale for (A=4 points). AP courses have an additional weight of 1.0 (A=5 points). PLTW courses have a weight of .75 (A=4.75). Dual Credit Courses have either a .75 or 1.0 weight based on School Board approval. We do not rank but have a Cum Laude System: Summa Cum Laude = 4.0 & above; Magna Cum Laude = 3.75-3.99; Cum Laude = 3.5-3.749.
